

Christening Blanket Baby Crochet Pattern Printable PDF

This beautiful christening blanket baby crochet pattern is a timeless heirloom crochet project that will be treasured for years to come. The best part is that this is a fast crochet baby blanket for a baptism or blessing blanket.

Repeating Crochet Stitch

If you can crochet the single crochet and double crochet stitch, you can complete this pattern. The double crochet stitch adds a ton of personality while remaining delicate and beautiful.

Directions: Christening Blanket Baby Crochet pattern

Skill Level

Advanced Beginner

Gauge

13 stitches per 4 inches. (1 skein made 24 rows of the blanket for me).

Size

37 X 37 Inches

If you wanted to make it narrower or wider, I would use multiples of 8 + 2. Longer or shorter just decrease or add rows. This blanket is $8 \times 17 = 136 + 2 = 138$ beginning chain stitches.

Materials

White Caron Simply Soft yarn 3 skeins or 945 yards.

Size I Crochet Hook 5.5MM

Yarn Needle

Scissors



Abbreviations

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

SC = Single Crochet

ST = Stitches

STs = Stitches

SP = Space

[] = Repeat Between

Crochet Pattern Directions:

Chain 138

Row 1

SC in 2nd CH from Hook [CH 4, Skip the next 3 STs (SC, CH 3, 3DC) in the next CH, Skip the next 3 CH, SC in the next CH]. Repeat across between [] ending with the SC in the last ST. Turn

Row 2

CH 5, SC, in the first CH 3 SP. In the same SP, (CH 3, 3 DC). SC in the next CH 4 SP, [CH 4, (SC, CH 3, 3 DC) in the next CH 3 SP, SC in the next CH 4 SP]. Repeat across between the [] until the last CH 2 SP work a SC in the Ch 2 SP. Turn

Row 3

CH 5, SC, in the first CH 3 SP. In the same SP, (CH 3, 3 DC). SC in the next CH 4 SP, [CH 4, (SC, CH 3, 3 DC) in the next CH 3 SP, SC in the next CH 4



SP]. Repeat across between the [] until the last CH 5 SP work a SC in the Ch 5 SP. Turn

Rows 4 – 60

Repeat row 3 until the desired length.

Finishing

Cut yarn and pull through the last ST leaving about a ten inch tail. I like to use a yarn needle to weave in the end going in a variety of directions back and forth until it feels a bit secure. Then I cut the excess yarn. Make sure to go back to the starting row yarn and weave that in too.

Crochet Border

Round 1

Sides. After last row continue on the side. [CH 4, SC in the SC of the row below]. Repeat between [] on the side. When you come to the first corner work CH 3, and work a SC in the ST just after the corner ST.

Bottom row. [CH 4, SC in the SC SP where the 3 DC were worked. Repeat between [] on the bottom row. When you come to the second corner work CH 3, and work a SC in the ST just after the corner ST.

Repeat the Side stitches and the next corner stitches.

Top row. [CH 4, SC in the CH SP where the 3 DC were worked. CH 4, SC in the SC SP]. Repeat between [] on the bottom row. When you come to the second corner work CH 3, and work a SC in the ST just after the corner ST.

End with the last corner STs and work a SL ST into the first SC of the round.



Finishing

Cut yarn and pull through the last ST leaving about a ten inch tail.
Weave in the yarn tail and remove the excess yarn.

Blessing Blanket Photo Tutorial

Start with a Single Crochet



Chain 4, Skip 3, SC in next ST



Chain 3



3 DC in same ST



Skip 3 ST, SC in next ST.



Chain 4, Skip 3, SC in next ST



Chain 3, 2 DC in same ST. End of Row
1 = SC in last ST



Turn and Chain 5



SC in the previous row CH 3 SP



CH 3, 3 DC in same SP



SC in the previous row of 4 Chains



CH 4



SC in the CH 3 SP...continue



End of 2nd row
