### Beginner Pattern

This woodland cozy cowl crochet pattern is a great beginner pattern. You can create one yourself in an afternoon.



### Directions: Woodland Cozy Cowl Crochet Pattern

#### Skill Level

Beginner Friendly Crochet Pattern

#### Size

Approximately 11 inches wide X 40 inches around.

Change the size by using multiples of 4.

#### Gauge

14 Stitches to 4 inches.

#### Abbreviations

CH = Chain

DC = Double Crochet

SK = Skip

ST = Stitch

[ ] = Repeat Between

## Materials

- 1 Skein Lion Brand Home Spun Herb Garden 185 Yards.
- Size H Crochet Hook 5.0 mm
- Yarn Needle
- Scissors

## Crochet Pattern Notes

This pattern is written in US Terms.

Work this cowl flat then join after.

## Special Stitches

**Creating a Slip Knot.** This is the first step in almost all crochet projects, creating the initial loop on your hook from which you'll begin your work.

**Making a Chain (CH).** This simple yet fundamental technique involves yarn over and pulling through a loop to create a series of chain stitches. It's the foundation for most crochet projects.

**Double Crochet (DC).** Yarn over, insert the hook through both loops and pull up a loop. Next, yarn over and pull through two loops on the hook. Lastly, yarn over again and pull through the last two loops on the hook.

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## **Directions**

Chain 40

### **Row 1**

In the 4th St from the hook, DC. [CH 3, SK 3 DC in next ST.]  
Repeat between [ ] to the last ST. End with a DC. Turn

### **Row 2**

CH 3, DC in the previous row CH 3 SP. [CH 3, DC in the previous  
row CH 3 SP] Repeat between [ ] to the last ST. DC in last ST.  
Turn.

### **Rows 3 – 72**

Repeat row 2

## **Finishing**

Lay both ends flat and sew together using the yarn and yarn  
needle. Once joined, weave in the yarn and cut off the excess  
yarn.

When complete, pull the yarn through the last ST and weave in  
the ends.
